A collection of Chinese blue and white porcelain, Kangxi period and later, including a globular teapot, painted with two cockerels and foliage, length 17.3cm (lacking cover), an export teapot and cover, painted with pavilions and coastal landscape, height 18.5cm, a wall vase, painted with precious vessels, height 21cm, a plate and two beaker vases (faults).

Condition Report

1209. Lobed teapot - missing spout and most of handle. Vase shaped wall pocket - riveted repairs. Plate - glued repair and haircrack. Bowl - small chips to rim. Two tea bowls - both repaired. Small teapot - lacking cover, chip to spout. Large teapot - cover chipped, filled and repaired. Large bowl - fritted rim. Small pot - lacking cover. Coffee cup - repaired handle. Trumpet vase - badly cracked and chipped. Other vase - missing large sections of rim.
