A George I walnut secrétaire chest, fitted with two short and four long drawers, on bracket feet, height 91cm, width 106cm, depth 41cm (alterations).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

2150. The depth of the chest is very shallow, so the assumption would be that it has been altered. However, the veneer to the top and the drawer fronts is definitely period, with later veneered sides and later made feet. The secrétaire appears to be a later addition also. The whole chest has areas of historical woodworm and there are some areas of veneer loss. Generally a good colour and drawers work reasonably well. The front right leg has a crack to the front.
