A French silver mounted acid etched cameo glass scent bottle, possibly Baccarat, circa 1900, of tapered cylindrical form, the frosted glass body shaded from apricot to pink and decorated with gilt enriched daisies between silver mounts, the removable silver cover embossed with flowers, total length 15cm.

Condition Report

1629. There is the tiniest of nibbles to the tip of one flower petal but this is only noticeable when viewed through an eye loupe. Otherwise there are some losses to the gilt decoration but in fundamentally good condition.
