A pair of Bohemian white flash overlay green glass vases, late 19th century, each ovoid body painted with a gilt framed oval panel of a head and shoulders bust of a lady, opposing an oval panel of flowers, within overall gilt foliate scroll decoration, raised on a similarly decorated circular foot, height 19.2cm (reduced).

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1605. Height 19.2cm. Both vases probably reduced, ie. likely to have had trumpet shaped necks originally. Otherwise both fundamentally ok but with typical wear to gilding and light wear to enamels. One with totally worn gilding to foot. Some gilding re-touched, eg. around panels.
