## LOT 1487

A John Rose Coalport porcelain part service, circa 1820-30, decorated with panels of floral sprays within gilt scroll borders against a cobalt blue ground, comprising teapot and cover, milk jug and stand, twelve teacups and saucers, twelve coffee cups and eleven saucers, twelve side plates, slop bowl and another plate (minor faults and restoration).

Estimate: £200 - £300

## Condition Report

1487. Teapot - finely crazed, spout restored, starcrack to body. 23.5cm plate - good condition. Slop - finely crazed, some wear to gilding on exterior. Jug - good condition. Stand 17cm diameter - rubbing to gilt rim. 12 teacups - good condition, very minor rubbing to gilt rims. 12 tea saucers - each finely crazed, otherwise ok with light wear. 12 coffee cups - 6 ok but with some gilding wear. 6 with crazing and/or faults. 12 coffee saucers - generally ok with varying degrees of wear to gilt rims primarily. 2 with minor chip to footrim. 11 x 11.5cm plates - each crazed with light staining, 3 with hairlines.
