A Wedgwood Fairyland Lustre Antique Centre bowl, 1920s, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, decorated with Woodland Elves II Spider and Web pattern to the interior and Woodland Elves V Woodland Bridge pattern to the exterior, indistinct gilt printed Portland vase mark to base, height 14.2cm.

Condition Report

1415. In good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs. The bowl 'rings' nicely. During manufacture the colours to the exterior have run giving the decoration an overall 'blurry' appearance, this is not the case to the interior. The gilding to the interior has minimal typical wear - primarily to the base interior. The gilding to the exterior has typical light wear to the normal places, eg. lower bowl above foot, foot and rim. There are some typical manufacturer's white patches/spots amidst the decoration and some minimal typical crazing/wear.
