A French Sèvres Art Deco opalescent glass circular dish, 1930s, designed by J. Landier, the underside relief moulded with a concentric arches pattern, moulded signature to underside, diameter 35cm (chips to footrim).

Estimate: £30 - £50

Condition Report

1608. Fundamentally, the dish is in good overall condition. There are a number of minute nibbles to the top rim exterior and interior edge. The interior edge also has a small internal crack, approx 1cm in length. There are a couple of small nibbles to the beaded decoration on the underside. The footrim has a flat thumbnail sized chip to the side and a smaller flat chip to the top, with the addition of typical wear and a few minute chips to the edges.
