An Art Deco Lalique opalescent glass shallow bowl, 1930s, moulded with the Poissons design of radiating fish, acid etched 'R. Lalique France' to base, diameter 29cm (scratches to interior).

Condition Report

1620. Fundamentally the dish is in good overall condition. There are some noticeable areas of heavy scratching to the interior, particularly around the centre and the faces of the fish. There are a couple of minor scratches to the exterior nearest the rim edge and a couple of minute nibbles to the rim edge but these are much less noticeable. Otherwise no chips, cracks or repairs.
