A French glass spaced millefiori paperweight, mid-19th century, probably Clichy, with vari-coloured spaced flower canes on a clear ground, diameter 4cm (some faults), together with a group of similar glass paperweights, including a Caithness lampwork and millefiori example, boxed, second quality, and another concentric millefiori example.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1610. French, probably Clichy, paperweight - there are several noticeable impact bruises to the surface of the dome, to the top and sides, resulting in small chips. There is also some light surface scratching and typical wear to the base. Caithness paperweight - marked as a second to the base, with only light surface wear. Millefiori example - clear ground - an area of heavy scratching to the top of the dome and a small chip to the base. 'MV' paperweight - there are a number of light to heavy impact bruises to the top of the dome and some surface scratching. All others in good condition with only light wear to bases.
