A Victorian garnet and gem set circular brooch, diameter 3.7cm (one garnet lacking), and an enamelled and gilt propelling pencil, designed as an Egyptian mummy case, length 4.5cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

549. Brooch: there is some deposit on the surface of the brooch which would benefit from careful professional cleaning. The edge of the brooch is dented in places. The back of the brooch has some lead solder deposit to the centre and the original locket frame is now missing. Mummy pencil: this extends in and out with a little help by gently pushing it in. Apart from one or two tiny chips the enamel is in good condition. There are two small Egyptian marks to the suspension ring suggesting that the piece is silver gilt.

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
