A Leeds Pottery creamware part toy service, early 19th century, comprising teapot and cover, milk jug, sugar bowl and cover and five tea bowls and saucers, total height of teapot 8cm, with a lacquer tray, together with a creamware teapot, a Staffordshire pottery two-handed jar and cover and three Chinese porcelain famille-rose pattern saucers and a tea bowl (some faults).

Condition Report

1509. Child's tea set - Each piece finely crazed. Jug with three tiny nicks to footrim, look like stilt marks. The five tea bowls each have small nicks/chips to the footrim, in addition one has a chip to the inner rim edge and another a small spot of staining to the base interior. 2 saucers are chipped. Sugar bowl and pot both good.
