Condition Report

363. Mustard pot - only lion passant and markers mark 'HC' in a canted rectangle are visible. The base edge liner support has been previously repaired but still has a split and some holes. The thumb piece has a solder repair. The cover has an engraved armorial. The glass liner has extensive chipping to the rim circumference.
