A William IV silver farming trophy cup and cover with figural finial, the ovoid body decorated in relief with garlands of fruit and flowers above a wheat sheaf border, flanked by two figural handles, each of a farmer wearing a smock and holding farm implements, on a similarly decorated circular foot, London 1835 by William Theobalds & Lockington Bunn, with an ebonized stand, total height 37.5cm.

410. Flange edge of cover slightly misshapen. Scythe is misshapen with small split at bend. Very minor and insignificant dent to body above hallmarks. Otherwise in good condition. There is no evidence of an erased inscription. The hallmarks are clear. Gilt interior. Weight 1723g.
