A pair of shaft and globe diamond cut glass decanters and stoppers, late 19th century, together with a group of similar glassware, including a pair of Waterford Crystal Colleen Encore pattern brandy glasses, an Edinburgh Crystal ship's decanter and stopper, six Thomas Webb diamond cut tumblers and eight matching sherry glasses.

Condition Report

1611. Pair with overall diamond cut detail - 28cm and 29cm high. One with riveted repair and extensive chips. Other with typical minor chips to body and foot. Pair square decanters - 24cm and 25cm high. Both in good condition but each have an engraved armorial 'Blake'. The remaining decanters in the lot are generally in good condition. The ship's decanter and a matching square decanter are marked 'Edinburgh'. One of the clear mallet shaped decanters has a stuck stopper.
