A part harlequin canteen of silver cutlery, comprising a set of six Edwardian table forks, London 1901, four tablespoons, Sheffield 1914, a tablespoon, London 1776, set of six soup spoons, Sheffield 1934 by Walker & Hall, six dessert spoons, London 1889, six dessert forks, London 1908, six teaspoons and three other spoons, together with composition handled table and dessert knives, within a modern teak case.

Condition Report

426. Case with small nick to veneer of one corner. The 18th century tablespoon has an engraved monogram. The knives are steel blades with composition handles - not bone as catalogued - and show some scratches. Otherwise the silver pieces are in good order overall with minor typical wear and clear hallmarks.
