A rare Staffordshire pottery spill vase group of the Prince of Wales and Windsor Castle, mid-19th century, modelled as the Prince rowing a boat along a river beside Windsor Castle, height 17cm, together with two other Staffordshire pottery figures, including William Shakespeare (minor faults).

## Condition Report

1503. Typical crazing overall. Lady - glued repair to neck with some repainting. Object in left hand missing end and painted over. Typical flaking to enamels, with minor retouching to minor chips to hat feather. William Shakespeare - minor retouching to black of shoes and hair. Prince of Wales - some minor chips and losses to applied foliage. Tiny chip to edge of boat above paddle which has some flaking. Minor pitting and staining to reverse.
