An early Victorian silver rectangular vinaigrette, engraved with foliate scrolls, the hinged lid revealing a gilt scroll pierced and engraved hinged grille, Birmingham 1846 by Edward Smith, width 2.8cm, a silver rectangular vesta case, the hinged lid engraved with ivy leaves, Birmingham 1896, a silver foliate engraved stamp case, Birmingham 1901, and a silver circular rouge pot, Chester 1909.

395. Vinaigrette - in good condition overall. Typical light surface wear. Clear hallmarks. Slight gap at front when shut. Vesta - small dent to side base edge, otherwise in good order with typical light wear and nice clear hallmarks. Stamp holder - replacement screw to ring finial. Front face a little dented, otherwise ok. Rouge pot - good condition, nice clear hallmarks.
