## Condition Report

321. Sheffield cup - makers mark rubbed, otherwise clear hallmarks. Footrim a bit misshapen. Split to upper handle terminal where joins body and similar smaller split to lower handle terminal. Vacant cartouche. London cup - scroll footrim completely pushed out of shape and flattened. Hallmarks a bit rubbed. Minor repair to handle. Small dents to body.
