A late 19th century Black Forest carved oak mantel cuckoo clock with two train movement striking on a gong, the dial applied with Gothic Roman hour numerals, the architectural case carved and pierced with fruiting vine, on a rectangular fenced base with further fruiting vine, height 47cm, with pendulum and key (some faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1070. Some minor damage to the carving and poor repair to cross and top roof moulding. Original bone hands but numerals probably replacements. Movement appears to be working and cuckoo, cuckoos but overall in a rather unclean condition. Some damage to the brass pendulum casing. Original key and pendulum. This condition report is done without dismantling the clock.
