A group of British and Continental pressed and moulded decorative glassware, late 19th century and later, including a grey tinted ribbed vase, flanked by tri-loop handles, height 21.5cm, an amber tinted vase, moulded with panels of classical maidens, each pouring water from a jug, a Carnival glass footed bowl and a group of Sowerby blue milk glass basketweave plates and bowls.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1616. The handled vase has a small bruise to the top rim. The blue vase has a long scratch to the body running approx two-thirds of the way around, starting near the base. The vase moulded with classical maidens has some surface wear to the high points. One Sowerby plate has a number of cracks to the pierced rim, another has a wide chip on the underside of the rim, with some plaster residue probably from when mounted on a stand. The other pieces are ok.
