## LOT 1085

A late 19th century French gilt brass mounted boule and red tortoiseshell cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the embossed brass circular dial inset with enamel hour and minute plaques, the backplate stamped 'CHLS Frodsham, clock. maker. to. the. Queen, Paris' and numbered '15951', the case finely inlaid with engraved foliate scrolls, applied with gilt brass rococo scroll moulded mounts and flanked by pierced fret panels, height 34.5cm, with sunburst pendulum and winding key (minor faults).

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## Condition Report

1085. Very good quality French clock, originally sold by a very prestigious maker. Fine quality throughout with only very minor lifting to the boule work (lower left hand of case). Glass lenticle panel missing. Good quality square plate movement that appears to be in working order. Original key and pendulum. Only fault found to dial is a minor chip to No. 5 enamel numeral.
