A 19th century French Comtoise or Morbier brass cased wall clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the pale blue enamel dial with Roman numerals and inscribed 'Louis Jaquine St. Etienne', the brass surround embossed with a figural scene and foliate scrolls, height 48.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

## Condition Report

1114. The pendulum is an original Morbier pendulum but it has been altered and is now in poor condition. The mechanism appears to be all there, but it is very dirty and an overhaul is required to return it to full working order. The strike has been altered to stop the clock striking. Some small parts will have to be made to return this to working order.
