## LOT 650

A diamond ring, mounted with the principal oval old cut diamond within a stylized heart shaped surround, set with smaller cushion shaped diamonds with a diamond set single stone surmount, between split shoulders, ring size approx M, with a case.

Estimate: £2,000 - £3,000

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## Condition Report

650. The principal oval cut diamond slightly draws colour and appears to be showing slight florescence, due to the shape and setting it is difficult to measure accurately but we feel the stone is approximately 1.9-2.0ct. Colour approx: K, Clarity approx: VS2-SI1. The surrounding diamonds are slightly whiter, with one or two internal inclusions. The ring is in good condition apart from slight tarnishing to the silver setting and to the wirework shank. The suggested age would be late 19th century but in an earlier 19th century style design. Weight 4.5g. Centre stone measures approx 1cm long x 0.7cm wide.

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
