Condition Report

661. Please note the revised catalogue description - the intaglios are moulded paste and are not agate. The four red glass imitating cornelian intaglios are rather rubbed, with one or two smaller chips to the edges, they are carved with a dog, a head and bust male portrait, a cherub and a bird. The other two grey glass imitating chalcedony intaglios seem to be in better condition, they are carved with a head and bust male portrait and an anchor. The split rings are a bit bent and distorted. Total weight 7.6g.
