LOT 2005

A mid-19th century rosewood and inlaid tip-top wine table, possibly Killarney, the circular top decorated with a radiating flowerhead motif within a border of trailing leaves and acorns, the turned stem above an acanthus leaf collar and a tulip cusp platform with claw feet, height 53cm, diameter 63cm (some faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

2005. There is some very slight warping to the top but the veneers are all quite stable and it is hardly noticeable. There are two strips of banding missing to the edge of the top and a few minor chips and cracks to the frieze moulding. One of the struts on the underside of the top has been re-attached at some point. The base appears to be in good overall condition.
