## Condition Report

1417. Red hair - approx 1cm square chip to left eyelid and larger chip to left side plait in hair. Uneven surface and extensive paint loss to plaster on back of mask. Some paint loss, particularly around left eye, top of head and edge of mask. Green hair - approx 2cm long narrow chip to left base edge. Minor paint loss to chin and very slight blemishes to hair.
