A Sussex slipware pottery money box, dated 1887, in the form of a cylindrical beehive with knob finial and single horizontal cut coin slot, yellow slip inscribed 'Sophronia Catt 1887', maker's mark 'JJ' to base, height 13.1cm (restored).

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

1407. Typical crazing to glaze. Restoration around the knob across the diameter of the surface where the text is, at an angle to the money slot, meaning '...ATT. 1887' has been re-written, and in sporadic areas over the first two ridges of the hive. It is professional restoration but due to its colouring it is fairly noticeable. There is some minor chipping to the 3rd and 4th ridges of the hive, and a small blemish to the footrim.
