A Japanese Satsuma earthenware bottle vase, Meiji period, painted and gilt with opposing panels of a seated figure and a bird on a blossoming branch, height 13.5cm, together with a Satsuma bottle vase, painted and gilt with a dragon, height 24cm, and a Satsuma vase, Meiji period, painted and gilt with simulated brocade panels, height 15.5cm.

## Condition Report

1089. Dragon bottle vase - overall fine crazing to glaze. Gilding to dragon's head and flaming pearl rubbed, minor re-touching to head, otherwise in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Figural smallest vase - overall fine crazing to glaze. Gilt rim rubbed with other typical light wear overall, otherwise in good condition. Patterned vase - overall stained fine crazing to glaze, but in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.
