Condition Report

2429. Overall generally good condition with overall light surface wear typical to its age. Two of the small support pin heads at the joint of the collar and main body are missing. Some of cement around the hardstone panels is more visible than other areas. There is a small dent to the underside of the base and a few very small scratches. No marks.
