A mid-19th century Continental carved ivory and white metal mounted snuff box desk seal, probably Austro-Hungarian, finely modelled in the form of a lady's hand fitted with a turquoise set ring and bracelet, the white metal sleeve set with turquoise mounts and a band of alternating red and green gems, the hinged seal matrix engraved with a coat of arms, length 15.5cm.

Condition Report

2460. The index finger has a neat repair to its tip. There is a natural hairline running along the side of the hand. There is an area of loss to the silver scrolls between two of the turquoise mounts. The hinge is slightly loose to the lid of the snuff compartment.
