## LOT 421

A silver and blue enameled ten-piece dressing table set, comprising a hand mirror, two hairbrushes, two clothes brushes, comb, two rectangular cut glass perfume bottles and stoppers and two circular cut glass jars, London 1929, 1935, 1936 and 1937 by Mappin & Webb, together with a matched nail buffer, Birmingham 1933 by Turner & Simpson Ltd (faults to glass).

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## Condition Report

421. Two bottles - one with chip to shoulder of glass, enamel and silver okay with rubbed marks. The other with chip to enamel and rubbed marks, glass is okay. Two cylinder jars - one with badly chipped enamel, other with small chip to enamel. One glass jar broken and glued. Hand mirror - tiny chip to enamel on handle and scratches to enamel. Two hairbrushes - both enamels are scratched but otherwise okay. Marks slightly rubbed. Two clothes brushes - both with scratched enamel, otherwise okay. Comb - enamel okay and combs okay. Buffer - good condition.

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
