Condition Report

347. All in generally good condition. Typical light surface wear and scratches. One mother-of-pearl fork handle has re-glued chip to end. Another mother-of-pearl fork handle has a chip to end of handle which has been polished out. Other handles in good condition. Interior fittings a bit tired and some of the sectioning pins are detached so when closed some of the cutlery falls out.
