## Condition Report

1190. Good condition, no significant damage or repair. Couple of typical shrinkage hairlines to ivory, but nothing of any real consequence. Tiny repair to the knot on the back of his hair, but only really noticeable under magnification. Good signature plaque. No line to his rod, but rod is in good order.
