LOT 1011

A Chinese blue and white export porcelain circular dish, mark of Jiaqing but Kangxi period, the centre painted with a scene of three figures with a trellis and flower vignette rim, underglaze blue six character mark and double ring to base, diameter 26.7cm (cracked and chipped), together with a similarly decorated blue and white plate, mark of Chenghua but 19th century, diameter 25.8cm, and a small blue and white dish, Kangxi period, painted with a large fish leaping from crashing waves, underglaze blue four character mark to base, diameter 16cm.

Condition Report

1011. Mark of Jiaqing dish - 0.5cm x 0.5cm chip to rim, and a 1.5cm x 0.7cm chip re-glued beside the other chip, and a 5cm hairline to rim at same point. Two other small chips to rim and 6cm hairline to rim starting at one of the chips. Small dish - good condition, very minor rim fritting to glaze. Other blue and white dish - one tiny chip to rim, otherwise good.
