A Chinese famille rose export porcelain vase, Qianlong period, of baluster form, painted with lotus and butterflies, height 17.5cm, together with a pair of Chinese Canton famille rose cups and saucers (one cup cracked, chip to rim of one saucer), and a Japanese cloisonné teapot and cover, height 16cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1227. Vase - good condition but possibly slightly reduced rim (ground down) and slight wear to enamels. One cup - hairline crack. One cup - good condition. Both saucers with very minor rim chips, otherwise good. Cloisonné pot - minor enamel loss just below spout and couple of minor hairlines, otherwise good.
