A Chinese wood circular stand, late Qing dynasty, the frieze carved and pierced with chrysanthemums and lingzhi, diameter 27cm, together with three other Chinese carved wood stands and an Indian carved ebony stand, raised on three elephant supports (some faults).

Condition Report

1165. All a bit dirty and dusty and would benefit from a clean/polish. Carved and pierced apron pale brown stand - good condition. Tall stand on scroll legs - chip to rim edge and stretcher broken and repaired. Small section of apron split and part missing. Heavily carved pine decorated stand - good condition. Oval stand - good condition. Ebony elephant stand - minor chips to feet and one elephant with small repair to trunk, otherwise good condition.
