A George III silver wine funnel with reeded rims and detachable pierced bowl, London 1803, indistinct maker's mark, height 13cm, together with a silver two handled trophy cup with gadrooned rim, Sheffield 1911, height 13cm, a group of other silver items, including a sugar caster and pair of napkin rings, a plated cocktail shaker and two plated wine coasters.

Condition Report

322. Wine funnel - repair to spout and misshapen rims. End of spout damaged and hook to bowl broken. Dents to bowl. Good clear hallmarks except from makers mark which is rubbed. Trophy, smaller trophy, 4 spoons, wine funnel and two napkin rings - weight 516g. 6 bean end spoons - weight 51g (obviously bean ends not silver). Caster - weight 131g (small amount of filler to base).
