A collection of twenty Chinese hardwood stands, late 19th century and 20th century, comprising fifteen circular, three rectangular, an oval example and one of hexagonal form, the majority with carved decoration (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Set of 3 stands 13.5cm - diameter, good condition. 14cm long square stand - good condition, typical nicks. 19cm long rectangular stand - good condition, typical nicks. Large low stand 22cm diameter - natural shrinkage cracks and minor nicks, otherwise good condition. Large scroll leg stand 20.5cm diameter, 16.5cm high - good condition. Oval stand 15cm long - chips to rim, otherwise ok. Tall slender leg stand height 17cm - section of apron split and repaired, otherwise good condition. Circular stand 13.2cm diameter - good condition. Circular stand 11.8cm diameter - good condition. Square plinth 9cm wide - good condition but dirty. Hexagonal stand 11.5cm long - natural shrinkage cracks, otherwise good. Small scroll leg stand 12.5cm diameter, height 9cm - good condition. Small scroll leg stand 12cm diameter, height 7.5cm - good condition. Circular stand diameter 16.5cm - good condition, centre has glue residue. Square scroll edged stand 16.5cm wide - good condition.
