A group of three pieces of blue and white shipwreck cargo porcelain, first half of the 17th century, comprising a wine cup, painted with a dragon, height 4.2cm, and two 'rice cake' circular boxes and covers, diameters 4.8cm (both covers repaired), together with a Tek Sing cargo bowl and six various jarlets, 14th century and later, heights ranging from 3.1cm to 7.5cm.

Condition Report

1244. Dragon wine cup - ok but minor chips to rim and footrim. Both circular boxes and covers have broken and repaired covers. Tek Sing bowl in good condition. All small pots/jarlets in good condition, some with very minor chips, but nothing significant.
