A Worcester porcelain scale blue ground cabinet plate, circa 1770, enamelled with birds in gilt scroll edged panels, fretted square mark in underglaze blue to base, diameter 22.5cm (cracked), together with a small group of late 18th/early 19th century English teawares.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1476. Worcester plate - approx 45cm long by 1cm wide section of rim broken away and visibly restored back. Three approx 2cm long curved haircracks to rim. Branched haircrack running around approx half the circumference of the plates well. Overall surface scratches. Two tea bowls - one cracked, other okay with typical wear. Two saucers - one okay but worn, other with starcrack and wear. Two plates - both okay but with wear.
