A Chinese Canton famille rose enamelled circular box and cover, late 19th century, decorated with dragons amidst vapours, height 8.5cm, together with two Chinese famille rose porcelain cylindrical boxes and covers, heights 11.5cm and 9.7cm (both covers repaired), a sang-de-boeuf glazed shallow circular bowl with copper lining and hardwood lid, diameter 13cm, and a porcelain paperweight in the form of a pumpkin, height 5cm.

Condition Report

1239. Fruit - wear/scuffs to glaze and chip to stalk. Canton circular box - good condition, only very minor rim chi-ps to base and slight glaze staining to interior of base. Sang-de-bouef glazed bowl - good condition. Larger cylindrical bowl and cover - restoration to rim of cover and some wear to gilt and enamels, otherwise ok. Smaller cylindrical box and cover - cover broken in half and glued and chipped. Rim chips to body.
