A Japanese underglaze blue and red porcelain teapot and cover by Makuzu Kozan, Meiji period, of oval form, moulded in relief with pinkish red carp leaping from and above blue and white waves, below blue clouds and vapours rising to a pierced rim, the cover with carp finial, underglaze blue six character mark to base, height 15cm (damage to pierced rim).

## Condition Report

1030. there is damage to the pierced gallery which surrounds the cover. The front section of piercing is missing approx 3cm and there is a small section chipped and missing to the back of the gallery, otherwise the rest of the teapot and cover are in good condition with no cracks or repairs.
