Condition Report

1137. As can be seen in the image, the top 6cm looks like it is a metal sleeve which has then been overpainted and the colour has 'gone off'. There is also a 2cm hairline to the neck and a hairline crack which runs around the underside of the body just above the footrim, it runs for approx 3/4 of the way around the foot. Otherwise nice bright vibrant blue and good glaze.
