An early Victorian silver gilt castle top vinaigrette, the hinged lid decorated in relief with a scene of Warwick Castle, revealing a pierced and engraved hinged grille, Birmingham 1838 by Nathaniel Mills, length 3.8cm.

319. In good condition overall with nice clear hallmarks. Grille closes nicely but vinaigrette itself has small gap between lid and base when closed. Fitted with a later boltring to the side. Engraved initials to cartouche on base.
