A near pair of Bohemian blue overlay glass vases, late 19th century, of baluster shape, cut with shaped panels enriched with gilded detail, unmarked, height 28cm (one with glued chip to rim).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1621. Both vases have typical rubbing/wear to the gilding in the normal places, particularly the rims. In addition one vase has a 4cm long x 2cm deep repaired flat chip to the inner rim surface of the neck and a tiny chip to the surface rim. the other vase has some insignificant manufacturers blemishes to the rim giving it a slightly uneven shape, nothing terrible.
