An Indian gold, ruby, colourless gem and cultured pearl necklace, the front with a rectangular panel mounted with alternating square cut colourless gems and rubies, otherwise in a four row design, length 27cm, on a cord and tassel fastening, and a pair of Indian gold, ruby, diamond and cultured pearl pendant earrings, length 3.5cm, with two cases.

Condition Report

570. Necklace - it may be necessary to consider restringing in due course but otherwise it is in good condition. Earrings - they can be worn either as ruby and diamond oval clusters or additionally with the detachable diamond capped cultured pearl drops. It is likely that the rubies have been treated to enhance colour and clarity. The pearls have a few surface blemishes and each one has a drill hole at the bottom of it. The earrings are in good condition.

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
