### LOT 620

An Art Deco platinum, diamond and sapphire bracelet in a pierced geometric panel link design, mounted with cabochon sapphires and circular cut diamonds with four principal Old European cut and round brilliant cut diamonds at intervals, on a snap clasp, unmarked, length 19cm, with a Tessiers Ltd London case.

Estimate: £5,000 - £7,000

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### Condition Report

620. The diamonds are generally attractive white stones with some degree of fluorescence. Some of the diamonds have one or two piqué inclusions, however the overall general quality is good. The cabochon sapphires are of medium colour saturation with slight variation of proportions. The backs of the principal diamond set links have wire supporting corners that extend beyond the boundary of the back of the link construction, their purpose is unclear. To the back of the bracelet along one edge are three threaded holes, the purpose of which is also unclear. It is possible that the four principal diamonds are a later addition to the original design. Weight 53.7g.

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
