A white gold, platinum and diamond ring in a curved oval panel shaped openwork design, collet set with the principal cushion shaped diamond between two groups of three cushion shaped diamonds and an oval openwork surround, set with cushion shaped diamonds, between diamond single stone shoulders, detailed '18ct & Plat', ring size approx J1/2, with a case.

Condition Report

675. The principal diamond has an internal black piqué inclusion beneath the table facet which is just visible to the naked eye. The diamonds otherwise are slightly drawing colour, some of the diamonds have a few piqué internal inclusions, with one or two breaking the surfaces of the stones. One shoulder diamond has a significant chip to the side. The design of the ring is a modern interpretation of an antique design. Weight 5.8g. Centre stone is approx 0.50-0.60ct, head of the ring is 2.5cm x 1.5cm.
