## Condition Report

423. Overall generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs. No holes or splits. Some typical light rubbing/wear to high points and minor wear to engine turning. Couple of small nicks/knocks to edge of base. No significant dents. Hinge is good and closes fully. Gilding is in good order with typical light wear and scratches. Hallmarks are good. Weight 142g. Inscription reads 'Presented to Thomas Turner Esq by A.D. & C.S. Smith August 28th 1852'.
