A Staffordshire porcelain part dessert service, late 19th century, comprising twelve plates, a pair of pedestal tazze and four low tazze, each painted with a flower study within a turquoise basket moulded rim, red painted pattern No. '3944' to bases, together with a collection of other turquoise glazed teaware (some faults).

Condition Report

1468. Dessert service - in good order overall, each piece has typical wear to the gilt rim and normal minor surface scratches. One low stand has a faint haircrack to the rim and another low stand has a tiny chip to the underside rim edge. Trio - overall crazed, 2 vertical haircracks to cup. Remaining turquoise glazed teawares - generally good with bright gilding, one saucer with minor nicks to underside rim edge.
